

Greensfelder County Park

- ① Roundhouse (Main) Parking Lot
- ② Branch to State Horse Trail leads to Fox Run Trail in Rockwoods Range.
- ③ Rock Garden
- ④ Connector allows for return to the radio tower.
- ⑤ Options here include descending Green Rock or Deer Run trails down to Eagle Valley, or turning left, and returning alongroad to bridle path parallel to Allenton Rd. Green Rock and Deer Run here are generally considered one way down-only trails.
- ⑥ Following the gravel Eagle Valley doubletrack west leads to another section of singletrack which comes out behind the Visitor Center. Going east follows the 3.4 mile loop around.
- ⑦ Junction with Eagle Valley trail behind Visitor Center.

Eagle Valley - 3.4 miles (Blue)

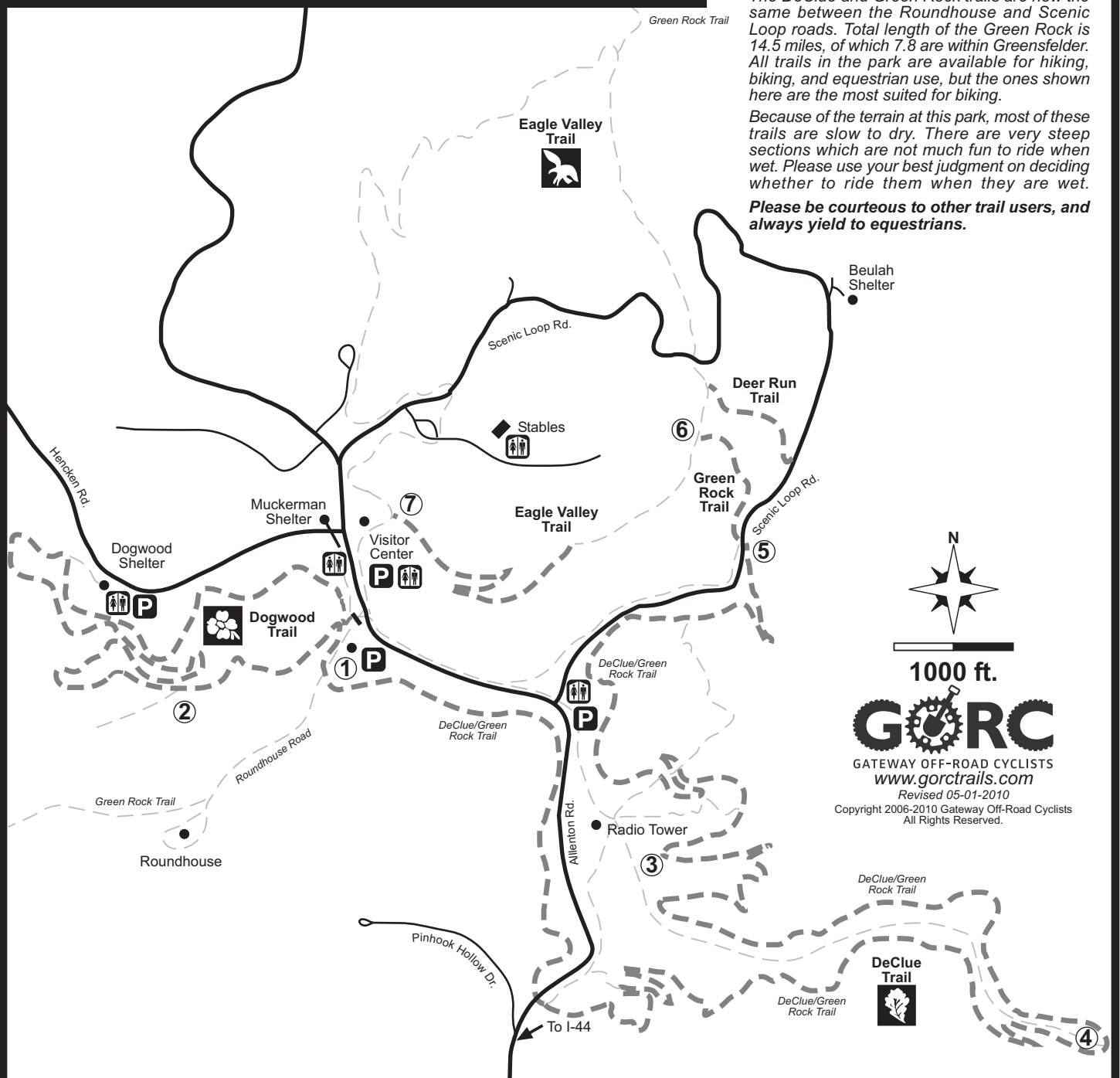

The DeClue and Green Rock trails are now the same between the Roundhouse and Scenic Loop roads. Total length of the Green Rock is 14.5 miles, of which 7.8 are within Greensfelder. All trails in the park are available for hiking, biking, and equestrian use, but the ones shown here are the most suited for biking.

Because of the terrain at this park, most of these trails are slow to dry. There are very steep sections which are not much fun to ride when wet. Please use your best judgment on deciding whether to ride them when they are wet.

Please be courteous to other trail users, and always yield to equestrians.
